Dear Parent/Player,

I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself and let you all know my plans for a Plainview lacrosse summer program.

My name is Chris Rogler, I am a graduate from Plainview High School, where I played four years of varsity lacrosse. I began my college career at Nassau Community College. While studying physical education I played lacrosse for the Nassau C.C Lions. During my sophomore year I was selected as a junior college All American and team captain, that same year Nassau won the junior college national championship defeating Herkimer C.C. 22-12. I continued my lacrosse career at Hofstra University where I was named team captain my senior year and was awarded the teams most valuable player in 1999. I graduated from Hofstra with a degree in physical education and became a physical education teacher in the Plainview school district. Yet, my lacrosse career was not complete. I was drafted in 2000, by the N.Y. Saints and in 2002 I was drafted to the Bridgeport Barrage to play in the newly formed professional outdoor lacrosse league. I continued my career with the Philadelphia Barrage and won two Major League Lacrosse World Championships.

Now entering my twelfth year as the varsity coach at Plainview, I have seen how this sport has grown and become a year round sport. Athletes are being encouraged to be part of club teams throughout the year and participate in tournaments. Last summer, I took part in coaching a club team and the experience for me was fun, yet unfulfilling. I created a summer package for only Plainview kids. This package will include everything that the other clubs offer (see attachment for package) and most importantly it will keep the Plainview kids together and will make us better as a program. I plan to carry 25 kids on the roster but if more choose to play that's ok with me. Current 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> grade players will be eligible for this opportunity.

All of the details for the summer are explained in the attachment, the one thing that you will have to do on your own is make sure you are insured with US Lacrosse player insurance. This insurance is \$50.00 dollars and may be used as additional insurance for any injury that occurs during participation in organized lacrosse.
